## Karen Foster in Cameroon

The outreach to Muslim people I'm involved with is called "Reach the Nations." Knowing that it's God who reaches hearts, we invest heavily in prayer. Knowing that the vast majority of people who are reached by the gospel are reached through other people, we reach out. I've written about M, pictured below on the left. Her interest in learning about the Bible remains, and N and I continue to visit her every two weeks. This week her stepson was there; a teen who was one of those who complained about her having a Bible. We chatted and joked with both of them, and when he was out on an errand or playing soccer, we moved forward in our study. This time it was Isaiah chapter 53, which is our last Old Testament passage before beginning to read of the life of Jesus. It went well. We could wish we

had more Bible passages memorized! I had the chapter on paper, and we discreetly opened and read from it off and on. Your prayers are part of this outreach. Keep reaching!



Thanks for praying about our re-organizing of the ladies' outreach. The six of us go in pairs to visit six homes:

- > 3 daughters of deceased Mama Ad: H, DJ, A
- > a neighbor of one of those daughters
- > M

> Mai – wife of a traditional chief ; a different people group than the others (pictured)

In our first discussion of the Bible with DJ, we asked what she thought of the Bible from what she's heard. She answered that we are the only Bible people she knows. She is 61 years old. No outreach to her in all those years?? When I mentioned that at prayer time, N said that her husband had almost been chased away by the chief (Mai's husband) when he began visiting. The chief said that he reconsidered because in 40 years no Christian had ever approached him; why not see what he had to say? Then there's the wonderful salvation story of Al, whom I wrote about in June.





Grace Community Church exists for God—for His praise and purpose and to display His character and compassion.


We are to worship Him, grow to be like Him, and encourage others to believe in and follow Him
