Back to Benin: Things have opened up enough travel-wise that our study Bible launch team is planning to meet for the first time face to face in Cotonou, Benin at the beginning of December . Dr. John Jusu, the general editor of the study Bible, and Abel, Barka, Genevieve and I will meet with Augustin in his hometown of Cotonou.

Our objectives for the gathering are:

*Learn from Dr. Jusu and his experience training others to use the English edition of the study Bible

*Finalize the adaptation of the training materials for the French-speaking Africa

*Do a pilot training time with a small group in Cotonou

*Meet with the radio journalists and producers who are making the radio programs based on the study Bible

*Capture some videos for our talented study Bible launch team

Greg's Benin Trip Expenses: The expenses for our meetings in Benin are being paid for out of the funds we've raised for the study Bible launch. This said, I'd like to be as careful as possible regarding spending out of this budget. One way you could help would be to cover my expenses for this work will be roughly \$1,500.

Down \$15,000 a year: Last Summer we communicated with so many of you about the financial needs we have for our families ministry support. For the last couple of years, we have had roughly a \$15,000 a year shortfall (about \$1,250 per month). Would you or your church be willing to consider making a special one-time gift for this year in order to help us make up for our shortfall? Or would you be willing to consider making an annual commitment for the next to years? We would be truly grateful if first you would pray that God would provide for the needs we've communicated. In over 30 years of ministry, our family can attest to God's gracious and often surprising provision.
