Growth in Cameroon:

Green things are basically always growing in the most of Cameroon, since there's no winter. As you lose leavers in the north, tiny avocados are forming on the tree in my yard. I'll get to eat some in March or April. My coworkers the Jensens won't get a share this time, as they will have left in the U.S. in February and will retire later in the year. I still have nine months in Cameroon and will retire at the end of 2022. Car-means plan to stay on. In terms of growth, it looks like the opposite, but God's view of things doesn't always follow our logic. **Pray** with us for growth in the ministries that we're involved with, as we pass on responsibilities to others.

We still don't know who will be teaching the wives of Bible institute students for the next group which will begin their studies in the autumn 2022. **Pray** for God's guidance. Jacquie Jensen and I will be here through the graduation of the current group at the end of January, 2022. So will Nathalie, our current Cameroonian teacher, though for the moment she's on leave because of family growth. Thank the Lord with us for the arrival of baby girl Celine on Oct. 8. This is Nathalie's first child at almost age 29 and after more than a decade of "marriage." As I wrote earlier in the year, the definition of marriage is a bit fuzzy here, but Nathalie and Gideon have been together that long and legalized it along with most of the Bible institute students in March. **Pray** for the couple who still need that official "married" paper in order to get their Bible institute diplomas in January.

Pray too for the growth in the general education level of the ladies I work with. Nathalie thought it was lots of urine coming out when her water broke in the middle of the night, the day she delivered Celine. She got prenatal care at the government clinic but hadn't heard of water breaking. And **pray** that we who work with the less educated will not make assumptions about what they know and don't know. We're often wrong.
