The staff and students at our Bible institute are almost all officially married now. I'm single, one student couple had just had a baby a few reasonable exceptions. Some paid extra to get all dolled up. One wore the new outfit she got at Christmas. It was a big hodgepodge with changes and delays, but at the end of the day they had papers in hand. Jacquelin, pictured, said some from her birth family threatened to come to take her back because the dowry wasn't paid, but she's still here. No doubt there were other rumblings we haven't heard, but we can **pray** that extended families see this legal step as a good thing and that the now-really-married couple will be a good example to many in their churches who have not made official their marriages for various reasons, and good examples to their own children, too.



We can **pray** that when these students pastor churches they'll teach well what the Bible says about marriage, and about everything else. Our pastors will need to do a lot of correcting of crazy teaching that many have heard.
