For visits to Muslim ladies, we have been a team of four Christian ladies for years: Awawo, Karen, Nadege and Regina, but God has added two more! Thank the Lord for Grace who transferred with her husband from another city and for newcomer to Cameroon with another mission, Becci.

We're pictured at a restaurant for a recent celebration of Regina's birthday and my new water meter. Seriously, the water meter was a major victory after a long battle. Three homes of the same owner were on the same water company meter and it wasn't going well. I finally got my meter. Another tenant got her meter, the bill on the old meter wasn't paid, the old meter was removed and the third tenant lost water altogether and moved out. Regina is pictured separately because it was her birthday and so you can see her pretty smile on her dark face. - We're an international team spanning about 35 years in age. There are lots of opportunities for cross-cultural frustrations and other challenges. - Now that we can go out in three pairs instead of two pairs, we can visit more homes and need wisdom as to where we should spend our limited available time. Only the Lord knows the hearts and which ladies will be drawn to the truth. Many enjoy our visits but who is really interested in spiritual things? - **Pray** for financial provision. Three of us are on full-time donor support. One works fulltime as a nurse and her husband has donor support (not enough for the family of six). One has donor support with her husband, and he also does part-time work as a bricklayer. The other is in commerce and is a single mom. Three are married and the husbands are also in Muslim outreach. H's household hosts literacy class and they and some neighbors hear Bible stories. And we might cut veggies.

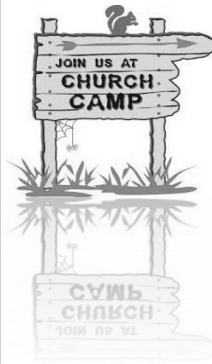
