VBS: During winter break it was a blessing to be a part of a virtual Vacation Bible School (detective theme) with my co-worker Sabine and a team of volunteers. It was a fun time of learning God's word, playing games, and singing.

Tell me your story Bible Club: This club was a lot of fun, as it involved "mystery guests" who told their stories of how Christ has worked in their lives. This program is an example of the creativity shown by one of my co-workers (Nina). I enjoyed being a mystery guest at one club and participating in others. 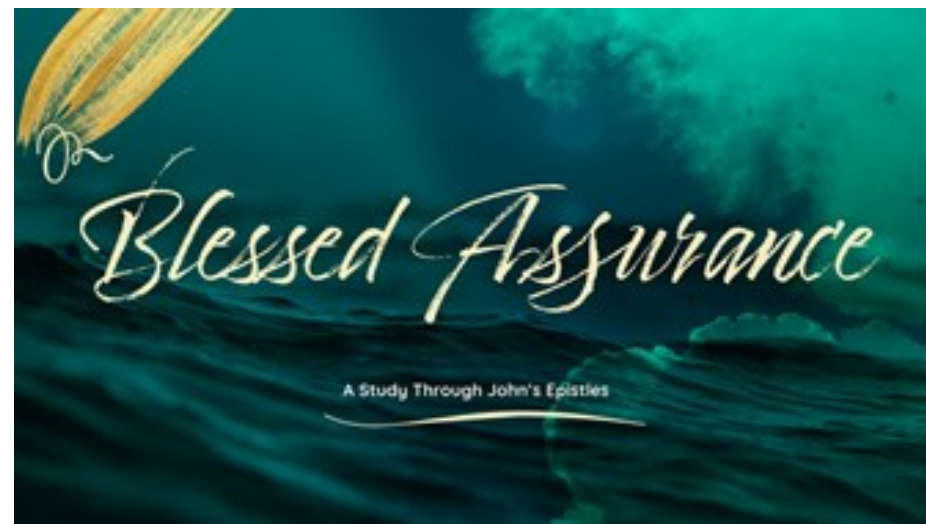
