Would you also pray that we are able to be planted and rooted in our home and neighborhood. This stint in the UK is showing us just how much our hearts long for rootedness. What does that mean when we hope to work with a transient population? Pray that the Lord gives us the answer and that we find rootedness in him.

Be in prayer for new family. Through our teammate R's efforts (and the work of the HS) there are new Children in our eternal family. Nathan* has recently relocated to our target city and started university classes this week. Pray that as he interacts with our team (and all grow in our ability to communicate) that they also grow in Perfect Love as we all grow in our faith together. We have also heard of others choosing life both in 1st and here in the UK! The Spirit is moving.

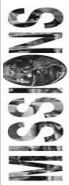
Donate used ink cartridges to GCC by leaving them on the church office desk or in the window. They are recycled at Staples in exchange for merchandise discounts. Thanks!
