There was a slide and fall on one of the motorcycles going down the steep dusty hill after the ceremony, but no serious injury. Some clothing bit the dust.

Thank the Lord for protection. All returns to home towns that I've heard of went o.k. Grads are starting their new ministries or looking for ministry positions. **Pray** for Richard and Naomi, the couple who both got diplomas. They came to school from another city, but they've been invited to lead a church here in Yaounde and are seriously considering it. The church they came from already has a pastor. The church here had a pastor, but he left. (hmm; not altogether sure what took him away) I would love to see Naomi work in the wives' program at the Bible Institute here, with current teacher Nathalie who is much less educated.

**Pray** for Catherine, the other woman who got a diploma. God just gave her a ministry of compassion, caring for her terminally ill younger sister and the sister's 7-year-old daughter, at Catherine's home. Pray this month for the long trip Nathalie and baby Flaurice are making to a woman's conference, to Nathalie's home area where the relatives have been clamoring to see the long-awaited baby, and to the national conference of our churches and some interviews of potential students' wives for the next class at the Bible institute. And no doubt we should **pray** for daddy Gideon left behind.
