“Adieu” is literally “to God.” I guess it’s like “see you in heaven,” but I can’t look up the word history in my nice French dictionary which has already left for the U.S. Kind coworkers the Carmeans have taken a couple suitcases full of things for me. I’ll bring the rest in July. Furniture is not worth the shipping costs and will be sold to neighbors or given to the needy. July 12 will be my last day in Cameroon. “Au revoir” is also French for goodbye but it’s more of a “see you later.” Pray for good goodbyes as I see people for the last time (on earth) in the coming weeks. I hate goodbyes. I don’t like relationships to end. Certainly there are things I won’t miss about central Africa. Electricity, internet connection and water have all been off at some point today already and its 10:30 a.m. I won’t go on with the list of won’t be missed. Ironically the U.S. Midwest just had a super storm and I know many of you lost power, too!

It looks very probable that Naomi and Nathalie will be teaching the wives of Bible Institute students for the next group which will begin their studies this fall. Pray for us to go over whatever we should before I leave. I just finished editing the wives’ lessons and will give printed copies to N & N and computer copies to the men leaders of the school. I’ll talk with the two ladies about how the program works. Nathalie is familiar with their program and taught the last group (3 years) but is not much of an administrator. Naomi is way more educated but only spent a couple months with the wives before going to study with the students three years ago, so she’ll need to learn to work with the wives at their level. Pray for N & N to work together well and for sufficient Timothy Project funding to keep them both on staff.
