Our residency permits. Friends, this is a big ask for us. The ability to obtain permanent residency permits and identification numbers is the foundation to all we can do here. We learned this morning that employees from another “company” were just denied their residency permits. The **unofficial-official word is that no residency permits are being given right now.** Friends, if this is the place where our Father wants us to remain, would you **pray that he grants us favor with the government processes.** If we are not able to obtain residency permits on our current visa, we will have to find another way or another country until we can return to try again. We are very grateful that there is a pathway for us to have residency in the city. At the moment, we (think) we have all the paperwork necessary to apply for the permit. If we don't have a piece of paperwork, we will have 30 days to find a way to retrieve it. Pray that if we have any outstanding paperwork, that there will be a pathway for us to get it. And finally, if it is His plan for us to be in more transition, that he would be near to all of us in our grief.

Our team. Our teammates from Atlanta arrive mid-July! We are full of joy that all three families will be together in the same country. **Pray** that we are able to support them in the ways that they need. **Pray** that they have favor with their landlord, notary, neighbors, etc. **Pray** for their health! And **pray** for the health, mental, physical, emotional, and spiritual, of everyone on our team. New relationship dynamics have lots of potential for new conflict but so many new ways to show Grace. **Pray** for their residency process as well. Everything that we are going through, they will be doing very soon.
