Professionally he designs and builds high speed robots that put labels on bottles and carton boxes. He has built his own house, fixes cars and stuff. He is an elder in our church. He is taking Bible Institute courses online and will have the equivalent of a one year Bible Institute program when he arrives. He is a leader with gifts in exhortation and teaching. Christine is a teacher of small children by trade and by vocation. She has quit her job to take care of her three girls and to be involved in the Trevoux church plant. She is a brilliant piano player, leads worship occasionally. She has succeeded with flying colors the Geneva Bible Institute online courses. She loves evangelism, including a Muslim context. They do not speak English. But now we are having meetings with Jean in English. **Pray** for mission finance director Casey, Jean, and me.
