That’s the prayer I whispered right before starting this email. Friends, family, partners, pray-ers, we have a pathway back into the country. It was not expected. It’s not 100% guaranteed. It will take great faith. But it is where the Lord seems to be. And once again, it’s going to have to be done in partnership. Would you prayerfully consider if the Lord is prompting you to help us get back into the country?

Before I get into the details, please know that our organization has been working very hard to enable us to obtain a long term visa. The process is complicated and nuanced and we cant logistically share all the details with you, but we have researched. I pray for you to have faith in God that he is making the way for us regardless of what details we can and can’t share.

After much research into every possibility and much prayer, we have decided (jointly with our organization) that the best path forward is for us to purchase our property in our host country. In order to support a long term visa, we will personally purchase an apartment that will be our primary residence. To do this, we will need to have the cash up front. John and I have been good stewards of our personal money and do have funds saved to put towards a down payment, but its not enough to purchase an apartment in our location outright.

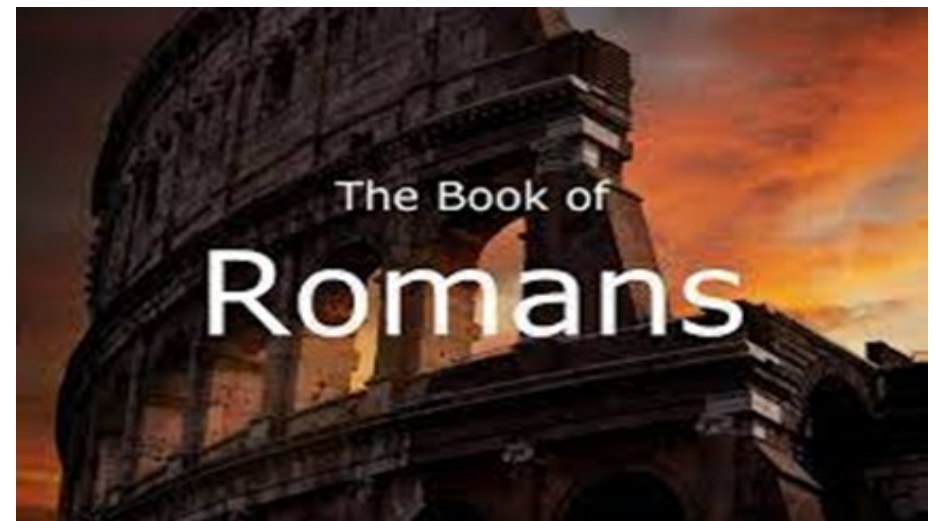
