Hosting—continue to pray for the events we host weekly. Over the Summer, we may also host church a few times.

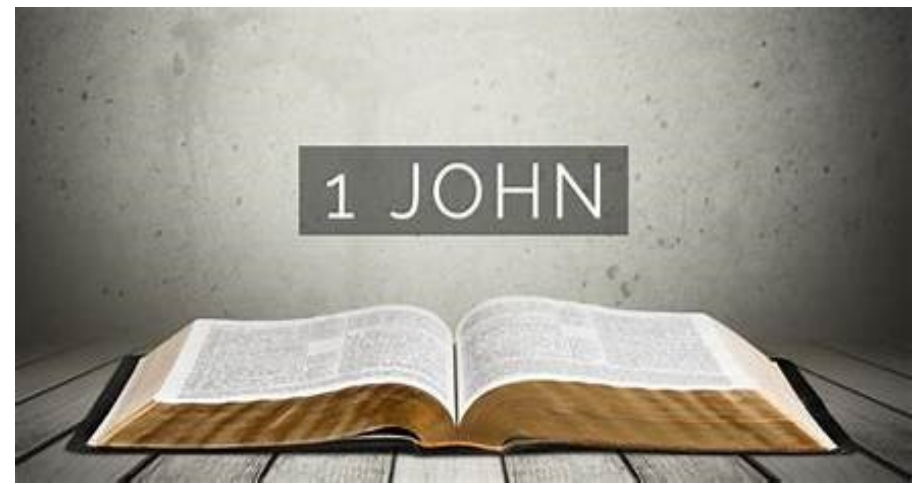
