Recently we have been asked to incorporate another Word of Life ministry called growing in English, which started online about four years ago, into the English Café platform. This ministry helps current native Word of Life missionaries who serve in their own countries improve their English.

Word of Life has many missionaries around the world who do not speak English, but they often need to use English in ministry. For example, many have supporters in the United States or in other English-speaking countries. English also helps in interacting with short-term missionaries who come to the field, co-workers from different countries and the home office. There are also many resources in English that could help further their ministry.

We will be working closely wit those currently helping with Growing in English and spending the next six months building new curriculum to meet the needs of these missionary students. We are excited to help lead this valuable ministry!

She has been greatly encouraged through her Gospel conversations with her student from Columbia, Nestor. 
