We had fun watching two of our teammate's kids while they were away for work. We also attended a goodbye party for our friend who has served here for many years and is moving on to the next chapter of her life.

This month A and I will be getting back into language after being sick for so long. However, my main focus for the month will be working out all the details for the conference in August. After the conference, A and I need to leave the country for our visa, so we plan to make a trip out of it. We are hoping people from our church will join us so that we can introduce them to what a real disc golf course looks like. It's currently the only one in Central Asia.

We really enjoyed our last zoom call with those of you who were able to join. It was fun getting to catch up on your lives, answer some questions you had for us, and share more in depth stories than we are able to in these newsletters. We hope more of you will join us for the next call.
