The past several months have been intense for many of us. What strange times! Thankfully God is still sovereign and reigning over all. One highlight of the shutdown period was more time as a family in God's word and more time praying and meeting with the CEF of France staff by video conference. Thank you to those of you who read, pray, give, and encourage. I truly appreciate the essential role that you play in the ministry. I wanted to take a moment to update you on the last few months.

Looking back to this Spring/Winter

*Wondersurf.com: The French version of wondersurf.com was extremely busy from March to June! We thank God that double the number of children visited the site, many completing Bible lessons, playing games, doing crafts, and sharing prayer requests. Several CEF staff members helped by making teaching videos or grading lessons.

*Teaching Children Effectively (TCE): It was a blessing to help evaluate the Bible lessons of teacher training participants (TCE !) twice before being confined at home.

An urgent need at present...

*Finances: Following the loss of some monthly support (due to deaths and employment changes) there is an urgent need for me to raise an additional \$200 per month in order to cover my salary. This need could be met with as few as 4 individuals committing to invest \$50 a month. Currently, I cannot be paid until this amount in monthly support is raised. 
