Purpose

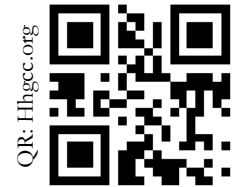
Grace Community Church exists for God—for His praise and purpose and to display His character and compassion.
