Karen Foster in Cameroon

In French, “les petits” for little children, so a literal translation gives you “the littles.” They are everywhere. They are the world’s cutest. And of course Jesus loves the little children of the world. They’re hanging around when we visit Muslim friends, and we hope they absorb some of the good news we share. I make a special effort to pay attention to 4-year-old Rowda (not pictured). She’s staying with M. and family for months now because Rowda’s mom is ill and overwhelmed. M’s granddaughter is usually there, too, and gets the bulk of M’s love. Pray for these precious ones to whom we don’t have much access, who were told at birth “you were born a Muslim and you will die a Muslim.”



In church, we often have not-so-littles caring for littler brother or sister. That can make it rough for big brother or sister to pay attention well in Sunday school, so pray for parents to keep the babies at home and to take turns coming to help as “surveillants” who keep order in the Sunday school crowd.

Thank the Lord with us that many littles come to church and are eager to participate in Sunday school. We had teacher training this month for about 20 that went great. Uncle Fred taught them patiently yet insisted that they attend faithfully and do their practice teaching exactly as he told them. He gave many extra hours of his time to allow the slower ones to get it right.



One cutie accompanies us on these visits. Old Mama Ajara loves her to death and thankfully baby Shiloh doesn’t fuss about being held by other people. Pray for mom Awawo (yellow dress on left) who carries her across town and into various Muslim homes and to our weekly prayer meetings.
