Elizabeth* was unexpectedly in the US for a year and a half due to Covid hitting at the end of her US ministries. After God graciously provided her with an extended opportunity for retooling, she was eager to return on March 11, as her country in Central Asia finally opened its borders, and she was able to secure her visa and coordinate her Covid test prior to the trip. **Pray** for her as she re-enters her Central Asian home after a long time away. **Pray** for wisdom and direction as she re-launches her endeavors, develops a local team to work with children with disabilities, and proclaims Bible stories and prays with these families.

In Chad, the School of Evangelism has trained hundreds of evangelists to plant churches throughout this country and the neighboring regions. More recently, Encompass opened the School of Missiology to provide a higher level of training for those engaged in cross-cultural ministry. Now we are creating a single campus for these ministries in N'Djamena, one of the most influential cities in northern Africa. We have purchased the land and are now seeking funds to renovate existing buildings and begin constructing new ones. **Pray** that God blesses these construction efforts and training ministries.

Purpose

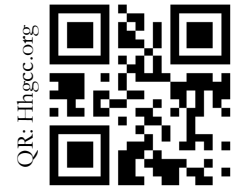
Grace Community Church exists for God—for His praise and purpose and to display His character and compassion.
